The articles are timely and often forceful, and they are intended to make you think rather than just deliver talking points cooked up by politicians and beltway think tanks.</p> <p>Founded in 2003 by Thomas Lifson, who writes frequently for the site and remains its editor and publisher.</p>

The talk radio show schedule has program from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. seven days a week. I get daily emails via Rumble (a free-speech alternative to Facebook). It’s a product of The Daily Wire, a conservative news website and media company founded in 2015 by political commentator Ben Shapiro and director Jeremy Boreing. See the entry for “The Daily Wire” for more about them.</p> <p>“This is the place for Conservative News because someone needs to challenge the mainstream media! Proudly managed by the Daily Wire.”</p>
Fox News	<p>https://www.foxnews.com/</p>	<p>Fox News, along with Newsmax and the Sinclair Network (see entries) are the only national cable news networks that deviate from the left-wing bias that permeates CNN, MSNBC, The New York Times, etc. Fox News (mostly Tucker Carlson) covered government misconduct during and after the January 6 protests and Hunter Biden’s laptop, exposed Covid hysteria, and raised questions about the 2020 election and the rush to war in Ukraine. Fox News isn’t perfect: It’s coverage of the 2020 election invariably (except for Tucker Carlson) includes the false claim that there was “no evidence” of widespread election fraud in 2020.</p> <p>The Fox homepage at https://www.foxnews.com/ has a massive collection of stories and videos taken from the daily broadcasts. It offers a streaming service for about \$5/month that contains many hours of documentaries that are worth watching, including Carlson’s long-form interviews with interesting people and documentaries such as “Patriot Purge.”</p> <p>My iPad has a news feature that allows me to choose Fox, and every article that comes up (about 50 or 60 a day) is readable for free, whereas many other channels available from Apple News require that you pay to read the articles. Every morning I choose “U.S. politics” from the menu on the Fox site and spend between 30 minutes and an hour scrolling through headlines and reading the articles. I think it is essential reading.</p> <p>Apple News offers its own headlines and links. In contrast to Fox News, it is a terrible collection of headlines taken almost entirely from The Atlantic, Guardian, New York Times, and other liberal biased sites.</p>
