

Election Integrity for Wisconsin Declaration

April 2023

Background – After over 2 ½ years of continuous efforts by many groups and individuals across Wisconsin and America, to get to the bottom of what appeared to be massive election fraud that may have affected the outcome of the 2020 Presidential Election, this Declaration will serve as a guide and work product for those that want to stay engaged, informed and decide what role they may play in restoring election integrity to Wisconsin.
